Volunteers help provide a clean environment and increase the adoptability of our cats by socializing, grooming, and exercising. Volunteers help increase the adoptability of our dogs by socializing and exercising. This is a hands-on volunteer position and includes exposure to loud noise and cleaning agents.</li> </ul>	<input type="checkbox"/> <u>Foster Care</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Trained volunteers foster HMSC animals that are not ready for adoption. These animals may be injured, abused, too young for adoption, ill, nursing mothers and pups/kittens, or adult animals in need of socialization. The length of fostering depends on the individual animal's circumstances.</li> </ul>
<input type="checkbox"/> <u>Humane Education</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Trained volunteers in this program conduct presentations on the humane treatment of animals, proper pet care, and the importance of spaying/neutering pets. Presentations are made in classrooms or other off-site locations.</li> </ul>	<input type="checkbox"/> <u>Mobile Adoptions</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Trained volunteers in this program assist in off-site adoptions. They help bathe and groom animals prior to the event, sell merchandise, recruit members and volunteers, and answer any questions regarding HMSC and its services.</li> </ul>
